PREVAILING WORLD PRICES AND LOAN DEFICIENCY PAYMENT RATES

WASHINGTON, April 21, 2021 -The Department of Agriculture's Commodity Credit Corporation today announced the following prevailing world market prices of milled and rough rice, adjusted for U.S. milling yields and location, and the resulting marketing loan gain (MLG) and loan deficiency payment (LDP) rates applicable to the 2020 crop, which will become effective today at 7:00 a.m., Eastern Time (ET). Rough rice prices for both long grain and medium/short grain remain unchanged from the previous announcement.
