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## **USDA Announces Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers in 26 Oregon Counties Affected by Wildfires**

**News Release | Idaho | August 13, 2024**

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***Producers in California, Idaho, Nevada and Washington counties also eligible for assistance***

**BOISE, IDAHO, August 13, 2024** - Physical loss loans through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

**Impacted Area:** Oregon

**Triggering Disaster:** Wildfires that occurred on July 7, 2024, and continuing

**Application Deadline:** April 14, 2025

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Baker, Douglas, Gilliam, Harney, Jackson, Morrow, Umatilla, Wasco and Wheeler

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:**

**Oregon:** Clackamas, Coos, Crook, Curry, Deschutes, Grant, Hood River, Jefferson, Josephine, Klamath, Lake, Lane, Malheur, Marion, Sherman, Union and Wallowa

**California:** Siskiyou

**Idaho:** Adams and Washington

**Nevada:** Humboldt and Washoe

**Washington:** Benton, Columbia, Klickitat and Walla Walla
