Federal Emergency Management Agency Amends Previous Presidential Major Disaster Declaration to Include Lincoln, Sarpy Counties

This amendment to previously-approved Presidential disaster declaration No. 4808 allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation, or to refinance certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available, and repayment ability.

Impacted Area: Nebraska

Triggering Disaster: Severe storms, straight-line winds, tornadoes, and flooding from May 20 to June 3, 2024

Date: This amendment was issued October 15, 2024.

Application Deadline: June 16, 2025

Primary Counties Eligible: Lincoln and Sarpy

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible: Nebraska counties also eligible for assistance as contiguous counties: Cass, Custer, Dawson, Douglas, Frontier, Hayes, Keith, Logan, McPherson, Perkins and Saunders.
