

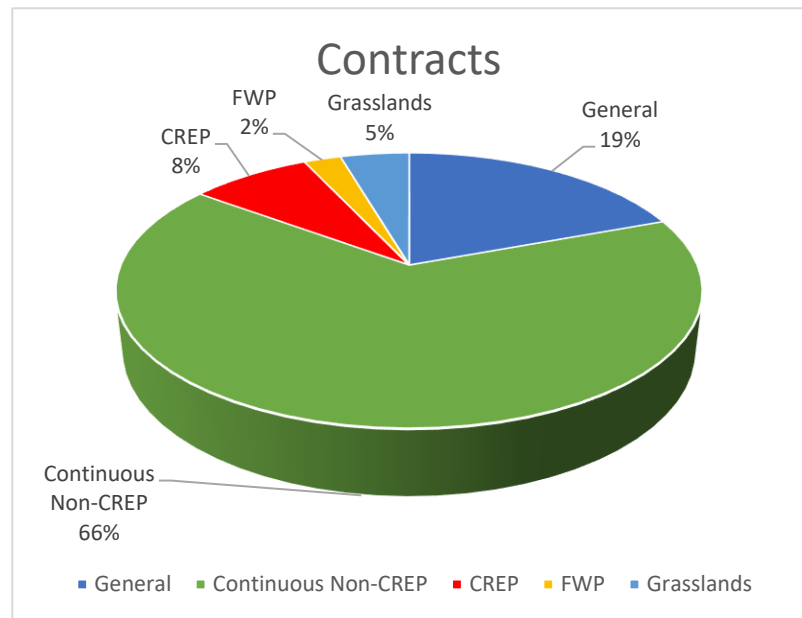
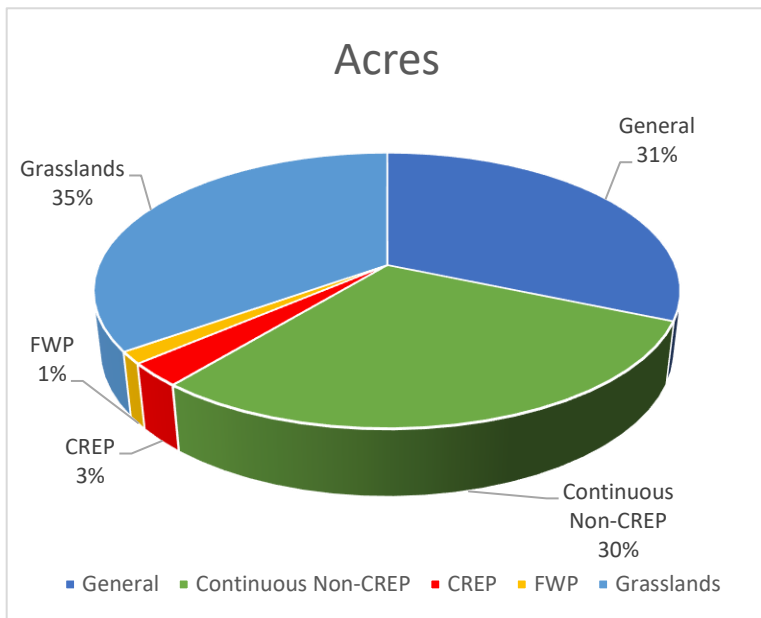

**General Signup.** Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

**Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up.** Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives.

**Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP).** Under CREP, federal funds are supplemented with non-federal funds from eligible partners to implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollment. Eligible partners provide matching contributions such as cash, in-kind contributions, or technical assistance. Eligible producers may enroll eligible land any time during the year.

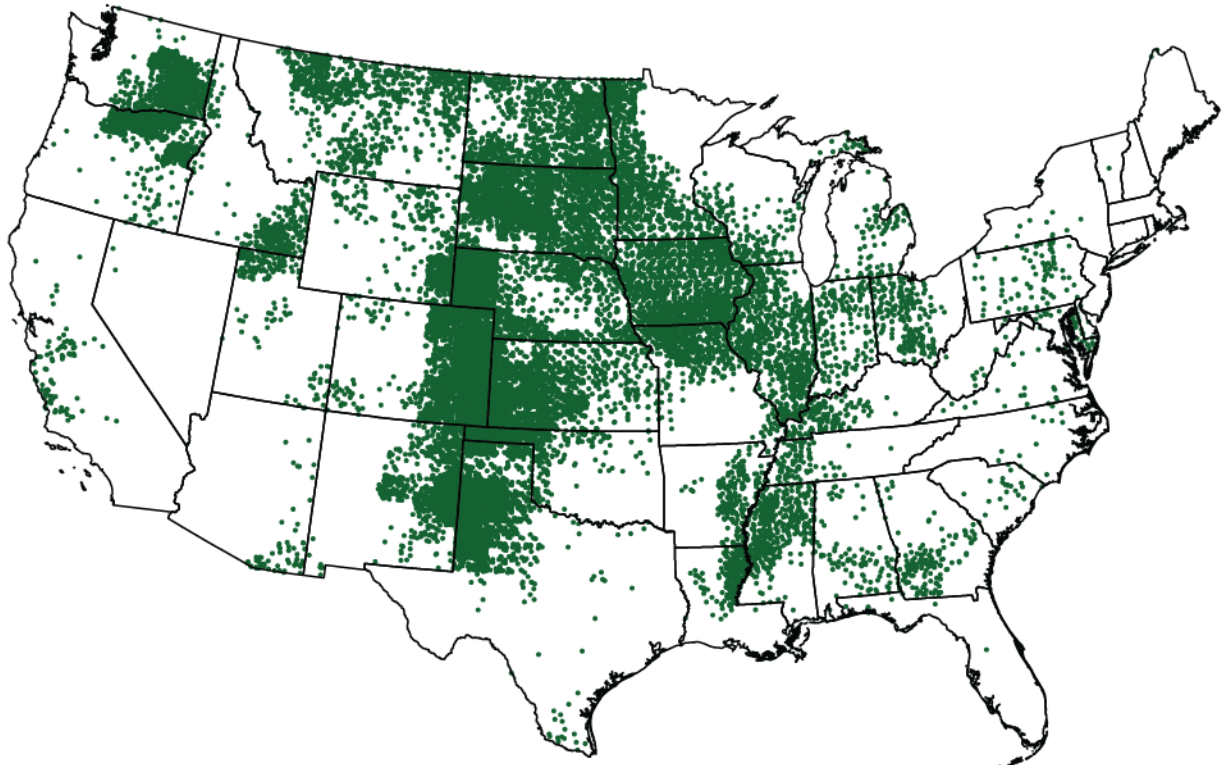
**Farmable Wetland Program (FWP).** Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

**Grasslands.** Enrollments are to support grazing operations and to preserve grasslands. No cropping history is required.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through the **end of September 2024** and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct miscoded data in the active contract files.

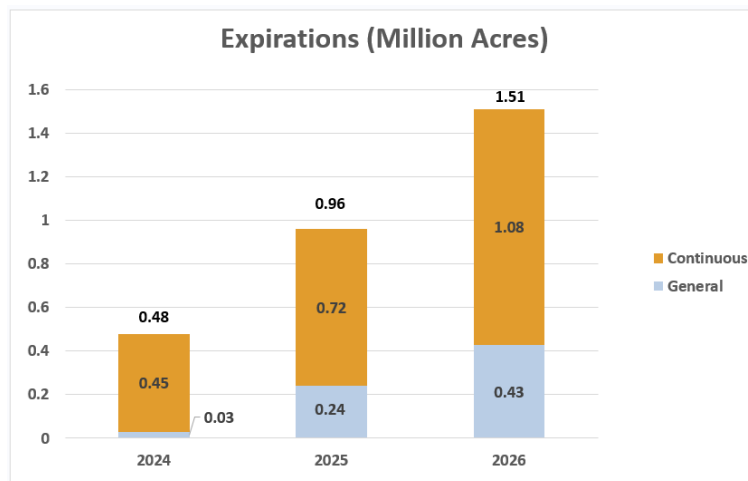

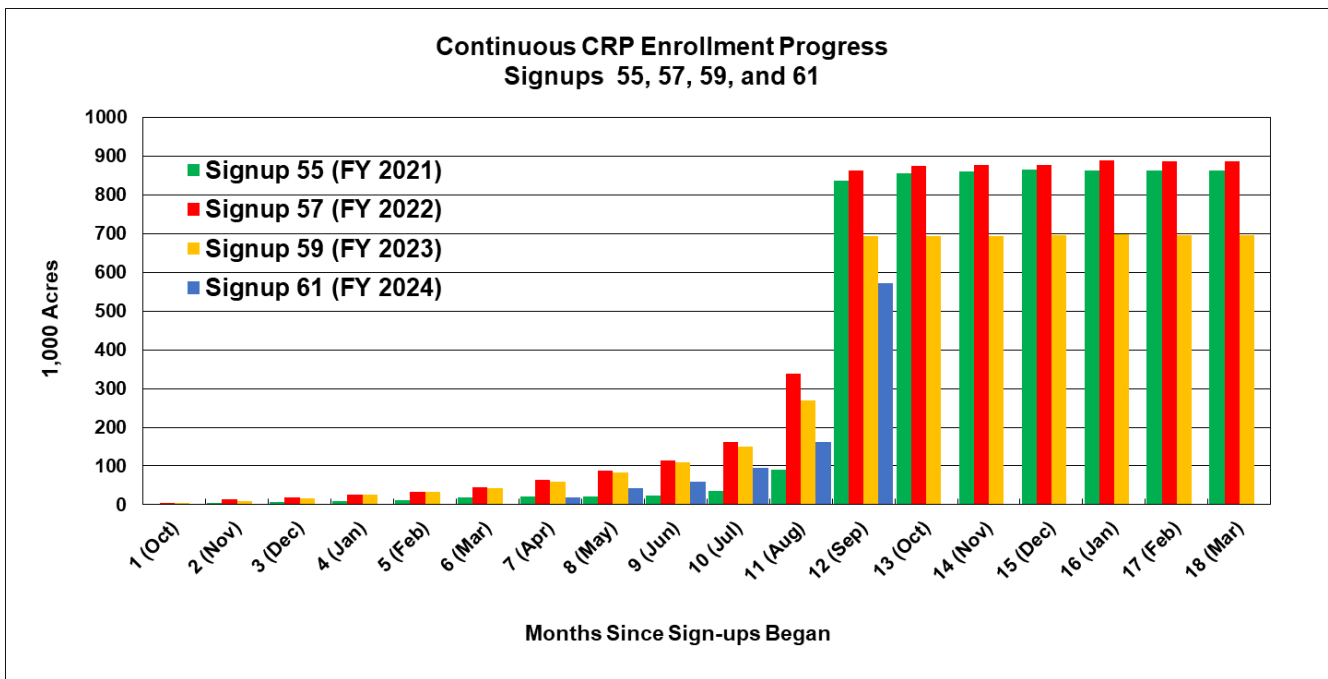
\*The Transition Incentives Program (TIP) assists with the transition of expiring Conservation Reserve Program land from an owner to a beginning, veteran, or socially disadvantaged farmer or rancher to return land to production for sustainable grazing or crop production. Up to two additional annual rental payments are provided to the expiring CRP landowner.



# CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM

## ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS – SEPTEMBER 2024

- Enrollment ends September 2024 at 24.6 million acres.
- FY 2024 continuous signup (#61) closed September 30, at 572,139 acres accepted.
- General signup (#62) closed March 29, 2024, at 199,214 acres accepted. These contracts will become effective October 1, 2024.
- Grasslands signup (#206) closed June 28, 2024, at 1.44 million acres accepted. These contracts will become effective October 1, 2024.
- In 2021, FSA enacted a Climate-Smart Practice Incentive for CRP General and Continuous signups, to better target CRP on addressing climate change. This incentive aims to increase carbon sequestration and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. CRP’s climate-smart practices include establishment of trees and permanent grasses, development of wildlife habitat and wetland restoration. The Climate-Smart Practice Incentive is annual, and the amount is based on the benefits of each practice type.
